
Please carefully read the brief newsletter that follows. It contains some important information regarding report cards and also some new policies and procedures related to our new environment. Thanks again for your continued support!

#### **ARRIVAL TIMES**

As you are aware, the first period class starts at 8:45 AM and dismissal time is 3:10 PM. Our busing arrangements see our students begin arriving at the school between 8:30 and 8:35 AM. For our students who walk to school or for those who are dropped off, again, please time your arrival between 8:30 and 8:35 AM. Our doors open at 8:30 AM every morning. If for some reason your child is arriving after this time, please have them use the main school doors on the northside of the building and please ensure that they check in at the office before proceeding to their class. Please contact the school office at 780-929-0792 to report an absence.

## **PARKING AND TRAFFIC**

I'm sure that you will all agree when I say that the traffic flow and parking situation around the EMDYS site is vastly different. Despite our contractor not having our traffic signage up, I wish to thank our parents for their care and attention when dropping off students at the school. Just to clarify, we have a parent drop-off and pick-up zone on the northside of the school. It is a one-way loop that is to be accessed from the entrance along Soleil Blvd. that is furthest west. To add to this convenience, the angle parking at this location is specifically for parents who are either waiting for their child or who need to come into the building during the day. If you are coming into the school, please check in at the office. We have reserved the parking lot along the east side of the school as our staff parking lot and for the vehicles of contractors that continue to work on the school.



Finally, please do not park your vehicle or drop off your child along Rue Parc which is on the east side of the school. This is our bus loading and unloading zone. Thanks again to all of our parents who have made the traffic situation around the school safe and manageable.

#### **SCHOOL EVENTS**

We will not be having a Christmas concert this year at the school. We are hoping to bring our gymnasium online in the next week or so but we were uncertain if it was going to be available to us or not in time for a Christmas function.

We will be planning an event in the new year that will give our parents the opportunity to visit and tour the new school. Stay tuned for that announcement! Until then, parents will have the opportunity to see the school on November 23 or 28 during parent teacher interview evenings.

The notice tomorrow will also indicate that you will receive a username and password on Monday, November 20 at 4:00 PM that will allow access to the Term 1 Report Card. continues. Students will also be receiving their username and password on Monday so they can monitor their progress.
