TELUS Wise impact (Grade 5 and 6) engages students in a conversation around cyberbullying, helping them explore and understand different options for safe and appropriate ways of intervening when they witness cruel behaviour online. A supplemental lesson plan and posters for your classroom are available to help extend the learning from the workshop.

TELUS Wise in control (Grade 7, 8, and 9) engages students in a discussion about cyberbullying, identity theft, protecting and positively growing your online reputation, and more. The program presents a series of digital literacy scenarios that illustrate the do's and don'ts and tips and tricks of managing your online reputation and personal brand.*
