# 4.1 Catholic High School

- -Nola attended a meeting with Liz Taylor-Sirois, Charlie Bouchard and Michelle Lamers (Board Trustee Chair) and the City of Beaumont Council. We were given 5 minutes to express our need for the new high school. The mayor and CAO's response was that there is no space in Beaumont right now and we need to wait for a developer to come to the city with the available space. The CAO was saying that could be approximately 2-3 years. We will then have to wait for services and development before building can happen so we are still looking at approx 6+ years. When asked if STAR could approach a developer we were told that it is private information by the CAO but then a councillor suggested a meeting with the STAR board and themselves and possibly a developer....so this is the next step.
- Karla asked if there was any more consideration for MDY to become a Jr. High/High School? Liz says this is definitely a possible plan. They will be discussing it again at the next board meeting and there will be a survey coming out to ask parents if this is something they would be interested in.
