• Valentine's Day and Ash Wednesday: This year, Valentine's Day and Ash Wednesday fall on the same day (February 14), and this means typical Valentine's parties and festivities in our schools will see some changes.

Ash Wednesday is a somber occasion that marks the beginning of the 40-day period of Lent and, thus, takes priority over the optional celebration of the feast day of St. Valentine. Lent is a specific time built into the church year that calls us to simplify our lives and focus on prayer, penance, and charity. The tone set on Ash Wednesday is meant to stay with us throughout the entire season of Lent.We know many staff, students, and parents look forward to celebrating Valentine's Day, so at MDY this year we will be combining the celebrations of Shrove Tuesday and St. Valentine's Day! Shrove Tuesday, also referred to as Mardi Gras, or Pancake Tuesday, is often associated with celebrations and eating foods that traditionally would not have been eaten during Lent.



Over 80% of the time, bullying happens with peers around and 57% of the time bullying stops within 10 seconds when a bystander steps in.

Bullying Is:



Physical:

- Hitting, pushing, shoving, kicking
- Stealing or damaging items
- Hazing
- Verbal:
- Making threats
- Intimidation
- Taunting, embarrassing, or insulting others Social:
- Spreading lies, rumors, and gossiping
- Harming self-esteem or reputation
- Exclusion
- Digital:
 - Hurtful/ mean texts
 - Posting Inappropriate messages or pictures
 - Sending harassing or threatening messages

7 in 10 youth experience some form of bullying

According to the 2019 Canadian Health Survey on Children and Youth, the majority of Canadian youth aged 12 to 17 (71%) reported experiencing at least one form of bullying in the past twelve months. Bullying is a form of aggression where there is a power imbalance; it is behavior that makes the person being bullied feel afraid, alone or uncomfortable.

The most common form of bullying reported by youth was being made fun of, called names or insulted (59%), followed by rumours being spread by others (34%), and being excluded from activities (32%).
