# **FSLW CORNER**

Over 80% of the time , bullying happens with peers around and 57% of the time bullying stops within 10 seconds when a bystander steps in.

### **Bystanders are Bullies if they:**

- Do nothing to stop the bullying
- Copy what the bully is doing
- Show support for the bully
- Join in with the bullying
- Laugh with or cheer on the bully



### Bystanders can help to stop the Bullying:

- Object to what the bully is saying or doing
- Show Support for the target
- Report the bullying

Be Confident... Show your kids how to have confidence by standing up for themselves when necessary- Know the difference between and aggression. Spend Quality Time together... When you make this effort children feel valued and worthwhile and this builds confidence Value Difference... Young people don't want to stand out from peers which allows bullying to thrive. Teach them to value differences in themselves and others.

### Instill a Sense of Personal Power

Teaching not only the recognition of right and wrong- but that you can do something about it and bring about positive change.
