
Our FUNDRIVE Donation Fundraiser will take place on March 14th & 19th



Over 80% of the time, bullying happens with peers around and 57% of the time bullying stops within 10 seconds when a bystander steps in.

Your child's class has been working on the skill of Responding to Bullying.

Each class had the opportunity to work with the Family School Liaison Worker, Mrs. Bouchard to explore bullying and how to respond appropriately when they experience or witness it.

This skill has four steps:

- 1. If you feel upset, manage your emotions and the stress. STAY CALM
- 2. Assertively (not aggressively) ask the person to stop. STAY CONFIDENT
- 3.If it doesn't stop, ignore the person, walk away and find a buddy. STAY TOGETHER
- 4. If it is hurtful, harmful, or it happens again, report it to a trusted adult. STAY CONNECTED

Please help your child learn this skill by:

- Asking questions about when and with whom your child can respond to bullying. Who is their trusted adult at the school?
- Asking questions about why responding to bullying is important and sharing with your child why it's important to you.
- Reminding your child to respond to bullying when you think the skill could be helpful.
- Recognizing when your child uses this skill and providing praise and feedback.

How can students safely help other kids?

Bullying is never okay, and if you see someone being bullied, you can make a big difference by taking action! Here are some things you can do to help:

Speak up! Let the bully know that what they're doing is not okay and that their behavior is not acceptable.

Be a friend! Being bullied can be really tough, so it's important to let the person being bullied know that you're there for them.

Get help! If the bullying is serious or you don't feel comfortable intervening, it's important to tell a teacher, parent, another trusted adult.
